## **IMPORTANT PUBLIC NOTICE**

Beware of Fraudulent Individuals/Agents Claiming Affiliation with the Embassy; No Cash Payment for any Service in the Embassy; all Correspondence to the Embassy should be sent through the only Approved e-mail Address

Recently, the Embassy was in possession of some counterfeit documents supposedly signed and issued by the Consular Section in the Embassy. This involved superimposing of signature and Embassy's rubber stamp, including other features which altogether confirm that the documents were forged.

This has further reinforced previous reports about some fraudulent and criminal-minded individuals claiming to represent or to be affiliated with the Mission. These individuals have, over time, extorted huge sums of money from unsuspecting applicants seeking consular and immigration services from the Mission.

For clarity, the Mission has neither authorized nor contracted any agent or intermediary to provide consular or immigration services on its behalf. All applicants are, therefore, advised to submit their requests directly, as detailed on the Mission's Website: <a href="https://nigerianembassy.se/">https://nigerianembassy.se/</a>

Consequently, individuals who seek the assistance of imposters and self-appointed/self-proclaimed agents or who seek the assistance of any third-party service provider, do so at their own risk.
